A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT

Department of Highways Professional Services Procurement Bulletin 2020-02 Statewide Right of Way Inventory of KYTC Real Property

This document constitutes a Request for Proposals for Professional Service Contract from qualified individuals and organizations to furnish those services as described herein for the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Department of Highways.

I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Consultant services are needed to provide assistance to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) to inventory real property owned by the KYTC. The successful vendor will verify and record target parcels including supporting documents into a Web/Mobile GIS interface as provided by KYTC. The initial focus will be to identify, document and expedite the disposal of KYTC owned property no longer deemed needed.

II. PROJECT INFORMATION

III. PURPOSE AND NEED

The purpose of this contract is to assist the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet in inventorying existing property by performing the documentation research to enter and validate parcels into a provided Web/Mobile (GIS) interface in order to advertise their availability for purchase to the public.

IV. DBE REQUIREMENT

V. SCOPE OF WORK

The selected Consultant for this contract will be responsible for any or all of the following:

- 1. Performing document research to verify KYTC-identified potential parcels for future disposal. This would include:
 - a. Deed research and verification.
 - b. Plat or drawings of the property
 - c. Notice of excess purchase if available.
 - d. Any other information deemed necessary.
- 2. Entering said parcels into a KYTC GIS real property inventory using provided Web/mobile GIS tools and including the following information.

- a. Geolocation
- b. Generalized property description (including physical location)
- c. Property photos
- d. Estimated property value from a market analysis, including comps (not an official appraisal)
- e. Other attributes to be identified as part of the project.
- 3. Maintaining inventory status as parcels are evaluated with the approved parcels being made available to the public via KYTC web based interactive maps or other means deemed sufficient by KYTC.
- 4. A subsequent project phase will include analysis of KYTC property to identify economically viable parcels for disposal.
- 5. Must follow the KYTC ROW Guidance Manual and appropriate Code of Federal Regulations.
- 6. Other requirements as determined through the life of the project.

Subproviders: Subproviders providing service under the work authorization shall meet the same requirements and level of experience as required of the respondent. No subcontract shall relieve the primary respondent of responsibility for the service. If the respondent uses a Subprovider for any or all of the work required, the following conditions shall apply under the listed circumstances:

- a) Respondents planning to subcontract all or a portion of the work shall identify the proposed Subproviders.
- b) Subcontracting shall be at the respondent's expense.
- c) KYTC retains the right to check Subprovider's background and make a determination to approve or reject the use of submitted Subproviders.
- d) The respondent shall be the only contact for the Department and Subproviders and shall list a designated point of contact for all Department and Subprovider inquiries.
