PROJECT NAME

OKI Northern Kentucky Active Traffic Demand Management Study

SCOPE

Consultant services will be secured by KYTC to conduct a study of congested urban freeways in Northern Kentucky. Specifically I-71/75 from the Ohio River to I-275, I-275 between I-71/75 and I-471, and I-471 from I-275 to the Ohio River. The Active Traffic Demand Management (ATDM) study will identify programs and or projects to improve capacity and travel time for all users within the existing I-71/75, I-275 and the I-471 right-of-way during peak AM and PM travel times between Downtown and CVG. The project will consider innovative measures such as bus on shoulder, high-occupancy vehicle lanes, truck only lanes, variable speed limits, ramp metering, etc. and be informed by the 2019 TANK Network Study and other ongoing interchange modification studies in the area. Deliverables will include a prioritized list of programs, policies, projects, phasing strategy and cost estimates.

SCHEDULE

The project will be completed within 12 months from the notice to proceed which is expected 4th quarter FY2020 (May 2020).

COST

Total estimated cost is \$400,000 using federal PL funds and toll credits in lieu of non-federal match. KYTC will manage the project with active involvement by OKI Staff.
