Department of Highways Professional Services Procurement Bulletin 2022-09 Statewide Bridge Inspection Services – Non-Destructive Testing

This document constitutes a Request for Proposals for a Professional Service Contract from qualified individuals and organizations to furnish those services as described herein for the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Department of Highways.

I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

In response to the Hernando De Soto Bridge incident, FHWA has called all State DOTs to perform non-destructive testing (NDT) on all fracture critical members fabricated from AASHTO M244 Grade 100 (ASTM A514/A517) steel. One (1) consultant firm will be selected to provide project management, NDT, and/or inspection services for two (2) years, on seven (7) bridges.

III. PURPOSE AND NEED

To ensure the continued structural safety and capacity of bridge structures for use by the motoring public by providing project management services through non-destructive testing on all fracture critical members fabricated from AASHTO M244 Grade 100 (ASTM 514/A517 steel).

IV. DBE REQUIREMENT

The Consultant team shall include a DBE Participation Plan with their Response to Announcement to help the Department meet the 11.95% DBE goal established by FHWA. The plan needs to demonstrate how DBE companies will be mentored or used to assist in the area(s) pertaining to this contract. An additional page will be allowed in the Project Approach (Section 7) to demonstrate this plan.

V. SCOPE OF WORK

One (1) consultant will be selected. The consultant shall assist the Cabinet by acting as a Project Manager of the NDT (non-destructive testing) action required by FHWA's December 13, 2021 memo.

VI. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

The Department reserves the option to modify the selected Consultants' agreement to include any necessary engineering and/or related services for this project. The firm(s) or one of their subconsultants must at that time be prequalified by the Department in the required area(s).

One (1) consultant will be selected to provide these services. The contract will have an upset limit of \$1,200,000. The Department may modify the selected Consultant's agreement to include additional bridge inspections and/or necessary bridge maintenance engineering services associated for this project. The additional related engineering services may be requested up to a contract upset limit of \$200,000 above the initial contract amount for each contract package. No additional service contract shall exceed \$200,000 without written approval from the State Highway Engineer.

- 4. Available team workload capacity to comply with project schedule. (15 Points)
- 5. Knowledge of the locality and familiarity of the general geographic area. (2 Points)
