SUBJECT: Notification of Administrative Modification #13 to the FY 2021 - FY 2024 Transportation

Improvement Program (TIP) and Administrative Modification #32 to the 2045

Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

On February 10, 2022, the Lexington Area Metropolitan Planning Organization issued Administrative Modification #13 to the FY 2021 – 2024 TIP and Modification #32 to the 2045 MTP.

Administrative Modification #13:

This action updates the previously published documents and tables. This modification updates two existing Jessamine County projects by substituting Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) funds for phases that were previously funded with STBG Sub-allocation for Lexington (STBG-SLX) funds. CRRSAA funds are 100% federal, STBG-SLX funds require a 20% local match. CRRSAA funds must be obligated on or before September 30, 2024 and incurred by September 30, 2029. This modification also updates the schedule and cost estimates for certain phases. The modifications are as follows:

Wilmore Trail Feasibility Study:

- Increase Planning cost from \$50,000 to \$100,000, and change funding source from STBG-SLX to CRRSAA. Change Planning year from FY 2021 to FY 2022
- Keep Design phase cost and funding source as is, but change Design year from FY 2021 to FY 2023.

• US 27 at KY 169 Safety Improvements:

- Remove the ROW and Utilities phases. No ROW or utility costs are anticipated for this project.
- Split the project into two phases:
 - Phase 1: Extend northbound and southbound left turn lanes on US 27 Bypass
 - Phase 2: Construct a westbound right turn lane from Keene Road onto northbound US
 27 Bypass
- Increase total Design cost for both phases from \$50,000 to \$115,000, and change funding source from STBG-SLX to CRRSAA
- Decrease total Construction cost for both phases from \$1,000,000 to \$599,000, and change funding source from STBG-SLX to CRRSAA for Phase 1. Phase 2 construction will be funded with STBG-SLX.
 Change Construction year from FY 2022 to FY 2023
