FY 2019-24 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Administrative Amendment #3

ACTION:

The Bowling Green-Warren County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) hereby amends the FY 2019-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to reflect project phases and funding from the Enacted 2022 Kentucky Highway Plan in the biennium and beyond. This amendment moves a project from the Informational Supplement portion of the TIP to the Federally Funded portion, adds new projects to the Federally Funded portion, and adjusts project information to comply with the Highway Plan. The funding revisions related to these amended projects are highlighted in the tables and information provided on the following pages.

<u>Other Information</u>: This TIP Amendment amends projects and funding levels listed in Table 2 (Summary of Funding), Table 4 (Federally Funded Projects), Table 9 (Projects Contributing to the Achievement of Highway Performance Targets), and Table 13 (Informational Supplement) of the FY2019-2024 TIP. The changes in this Amendment reference projects listed in the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP), Table 6.1 (Short-Range Transportation Projects), Table 6.2 (Long-Range Transportation Projects), and Table 6.4 (Grouped Projects), and therefore maintains consistency between the MTP and TIP documents. Additional funding beyond that previously identified in the TIP has been committed to these projects by the Federal Highway Administration and the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet. This funding maintains financial constraint of the TIP and MTP documents, and no additional financial constraint analysis by the MPO is needed.
