Improvement Program (TIP) and Administrative Modification #42 to the 2045

Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

On November 9, 2022, the Lexington Area Metropolitan Planning Organization issued Administrative Modification #24 to the FY 2021 – 2024 TIP and Modification #42 to the 2045 MTP.

#### **Administrative Modification #24:**

This action updates the previously published documents and tables. The modification updates the following two existing projects in Fayette County:

#### Mt. Tabor Multimodal Improvements

Add \$1,130,000 (\$904,000 STBG-SLX + \$226,000 Local Match) to the Construction phase

### **Town Branch Trail Mid-Block Crossing**

Add \$470,000 (\$376,000 STBG-SLX + \$94,000 Local Match) to the Construction phase

These updates do not affect fiscal constraint, as the \$1,600,000 STBG-SLX increase was allocated from the available reserve and approved by the TPC on November 2, 2022. Both projects are also considered \*Grouped Projects. The \$320,000 increase in local match has also been approved by the Urban County Council.
